

Maxx Hotel connectivity and things to do in Bangkok.

Please read this page carefully if you are interested in getting around Bangkok in the best way from and to the Hotel:

To Airport Bangkok BKK

Direct access through motorway only 15 to 20 minutes with a TAXI (70 Baht or 1.8 dollar Highway tax). 40 minutes by regular road. Taxi by meter about 180 to 280 Baht (depending on traffic)

1. Methods of transportation in Bangkok:

1.1 Taxi : Always ask to put on the meter, if they refuse, get out and take the next one, taxi drivers will try not to use the meter for a higher amount they will charge you especially near the tourist areas like the Airport, Patpong Street, ...etc
Meter starts at 35 Baht and fare depends on distance and traffic. Normally between 40 (1 USD) and 120 Baht (3 USD) in the Bangkok City area.

1.2 Hotel Shuttle Bus: Please see our schedule at the reception or the enclosed paper for the shuttle bus hours. The Shuttle bus takes you to RCA, Charn Issara (Patpong and Silom area, MBK Shopping Mall, Siam Square, and Central World Plaza). It also has an hourly connection with the Underground Train that connects you with the rest of the city.

1.3 Underground and Sky train (The nearest Underground train station is Rama 9 road station.): There are two Sky-train lines and one Underground line in Bangkok that allows you to avoid the heavy Bangkok traffic system. The following major attractions can be reached by these services:

Look on the map, for connection with Sky train get out at Sukhumvit Station and take exit 3 to take the Sky train at Asok Station.

** When you come back to the hotel and want to use the free Shuttle Bus get out at Rama 9 Station and take exit 3. Look for the Hotel Shuttle Bus according to the Time schedule. If you take a taxi from here to the Hotel it is about 50 Baht. Show him the hotel address card you can ask at the lobby.

1.4 Tuk-tuk: Depending on distance negotiate the fair before, a lot of fraud is going on when they offer you cheap excursions for one hour, you might end up in a lot of shops.

1.5 Motorcycle: Dangerous but cheaper and faster than Taxis in rush hour. Popular with local people because they crawl between the traffic lanes. Only for the adventurous and at own risk.

1.6 Bus: Very difficult system that even a lot of Thai People cannot master. Take the nr 517 or 307 at the Bus-station 100 meter to the left outside the Hotel. He will bring you to **Fortune-town** Shopping Centre, Rama 9 Underground and Tesco Lotus Supermarket for 10 to 13 Baht.

Night-time:

Cabaret Show: Ask reception

Patpong: Night Market and entertainment district. (Shuttle bus and Underground exit Silom)

Thai Boxing: Lumpini (underground and Exit Lumpini).

Near the Maxx hotel:

WALKING DISTANCE: RCA: Walk to the left outside the Hotel for about 200 meter, when you see the Bangkok Bank, turn left into the street and walk straight on, cross the street under the Highway and you arrive at Royal City Avenue. Discos, Nightlife, (starts at 10 pm) movies, bowling, karaoke, and supermarket (TOPS: open till 12 midnight) are available in this Thai nightlife street.

Ratchada Soi 4: Thai popular Nightlife area, close to the Hotel (near Rama 9 Underground station). Dance and Live band pubs, mostly Thai local music.

Pau Kung Pao: Restaurant inside/outside with live music, open until the late hours famous for its delicious seafood.

Ratchada Discos: Hollywood, Dance Fever, Pump Up, are Located on Ratchadapisek road, located between Rama 9 and Thailand Cultural Centre underground Train stations. A Taxi can bring you there in about 10 minutes and costs around 50-60 Baht.
